

Greenville County Low Impact Development Roundtable

Meeting Notes

January 16, 2007

Greenville County Square, Training Room C

Our January meeting focused on pavement within the public right-of-way. In our discussions of street width, alley usage and requirements, cul-de-sac design, and vegetated swales, a number of participants expressed a willingness to recommend changes to the current standards, provided certain conditions are met. Upstate Forever was charged with researching a number of questions raised by the Roundtable as well as preparing 'LID packages,' as suggested by Roundtable participants.

These LID 'packages' will contain a recommendation for giving developers opportunities to reduce pavement, provided that they meet certain conditions. Upstate Forever will compile these 'packages' using the conditions and research needs suggested by Roundtable members. At the next Roundtable meeting, participants will be able to comment on and revise the proposed packages.
