At our March meeting, the Roundtable discussed curb radii, planting strips, street trees and sidewalks. A number of questions and concerns were raised regarding these issues. Upstate Forever is currently researching several of the issues raised by participants, including:

- Minimum safe curb radii
 - Intended speed of vehicles
 - Driver's line of sight
 - ADA requirements
 - Safe pedestrian crossings
- Sidewalks
 - In vs. out of ROWs
 - Maintenance issues
 - Widths
 - ADA requirements
- Street trees
 - Maintenance issues
 - In vs. out of ROWs
 - Root barrier systems
